Guest Speakers:

Mr. Matt Harding – CMSD Transportation Director

- Canon-McMillian has 5,800 kids to transport in district (700 additional out of district)
 - 9 Canon McMillian schools
 - 27 Outside Placement Schools
 - 52 vehicles – 49 busses and 3 vans
 - 50 routes, 215 trips EVERY DAY!
- Additional Transportation Facts
 - Walking Distance standard to school is 2 miles for Middle and High School and 1.5 miles for Elementary and Intermediate Schools.
 - There are tools for video and recordings on buses, as well as GPS. If buses are speeding or experience engine issues, dispatch is notified immediately.
 - 3 children to a seat meets bus safety regulations.
 - Lots next to the tennis courts at High School are being turned into parking, but are still a work in progress. Should be available soon.
- Winter Procedures
 - Windchill Chart (see attached) The chart is utilized by the district in addition to multiple other factors to evaluate if a delays or cancellations are necessary. Final decisions are based on a combination of factors such as roads, temperatures, locations, etc.

- Survey was sent out on Sunday to transition year parents/students to evaluate programs in place to help with transition years.

- The School Board is looking at fundraising at the booster/club level (No PTO/PFO) to ensure these groups are following guidelines.
- Wylandville, Hills-Henderson and South Central are a part of the epic builds tech tools program.
- District offered teachers a google training course over the summer to gain innovative technology skills.
- Stadium update
 - Phase 1 – Field and Track
 - Phase 2 – Locker rooms, visitor bleachers and additional parking. - MID Bid
 - Phase 3 – Remove Central Office from sight and add more parking.
- Status of Old Buildings (Cecil Elementary, First Street Elementary Old Bus Garage)
 - First Street – Currently in completing due diligence period.
 - Cecil – SOLD, Closing scheduled for Oct 27th 2017. Working with baseball for a lease of the field.
 - Old Bus Garage – SOLD.
 - Proceeds of the sales will go toward the building of the new Middle School.
- Additional building timelines
 - High School to complete approx.. Jan 2019
 - Bid for Middle School out approx.. July 2019
 - Long Term Plan Wylandville 2022. Yes, possible merging similar to Muse Elementary.
