Meadowcroft Rocks: Free Admission for Kids

Meadowcroft Rockshelter and Historic Village will extend free admission for kids ages 17 and under throughout the months of August and September, thanks to support from **UPMC**.

Located just 40 miles southwest of Pittsburgh in Avella, Washington County, Meadowcroft is the perfect destination for families looking for a safe, outdoor summer adventure.

Kids can watch a blacksmith forge red-hot iron in a 19th-century historic village, hike through Meadowcroft's trails, and explore the prehistoric wonders of the Rockshelter – a National Historic Landmark recognized as the oldest site of human habitation in North America.
